

HOT TIPS FOR TRAVELING IN MOZAMBIQUE;

All you do is load 550Mt airtime (vodacom is best) then type in *122*550# and you should be up and running in 5 minutes. I usually reboot my phone after sending the code. Works like a charm.

OK here's a TOP TIP for MOZ: if you love always being connected to mails, bbms, whatsapp, news and ofcourse social media and ofcourse have a Blackberry then you must get a moz sim and buy a month blackberry bundle. Its 550 MET but gives you unlimited connectivity and especially good for sending all your holiday pics through BBM...in my view excellent value

For those of you that are leaving for MOZ this week, drive safely

If you do get stopped, be patient and polite. They will normally want to see your driver's license, 3rd party insurance and road tax (purchased at the border). A copy of all the emergency numbers with your documentation. Also remember to have copies of your documentation. Instead, start a conversation and be friendly and humorous. Some useful words are Bon Dia (Good morning); Boa Tarde (Good afternoon); Boa Noite (Good evening / night); Faz Favor (Please); Obrigado (Thank you) Lee

Basic marine rules & regulations – boats & jet-ski's

Mozambique: All foreign vehicles, boats, jet-ski's & quad bikes require a temporary import document available at customs office and insurance from agents at the border. Recommended to fill in – duration of stay 30 days

Fees:

- 1. Temporary import document – R 20.00**
- 2. Insurance vehicle – R150.00**
- 3. Insurance trailers – R80.00**

Licenses – documentation required:

- 1. Valid skippers ticket**
- 2. Valid Sea worthy / fitness certificate for vessel**
- 3. Safety equipment as per sea worthy requirements (South Africa) Licenses per vessel & angler:**

All vessels require a launch permit – valid for period of maximum 30 days or as per temporary import document (30 days), Boats – 600 Mts Jet-ski – 500

Mts Crew tax – 200 Mts pp (this is a new fee and we are still waiting for clarification) 2. Fishing license per angler:

Boat/jet-ski 400 Mts

Rock & surf 400.00 Mts

Spear fishing 500 Mts

Launch site:

Please ensure to familiarize yourself with the laws, rules & regulations PRIOR to entering launch site and DRIVING your LAUNCH VEHICLE onto the designated beach/launch area. No beach driving, only for the purpose for launching your vessel in designated launch area.

Launch area is strictly for launching boats & jet-ski's. Beware of swimmers and other bay users. Jet-skis are not allowed to "play" in the bay, launch site and swim areas.

No bottom fishing.

Bill fish – sail fish and marlin fish do have a tax to be paid if brought to shore. 150.00 Mts per Bill fish. YOU NEED THIS PERMIT BEFORE BEACHING AND A PERMIT PER BILL FISH.

- Valid passport
- Identity book with a valid drivers license - if self-drive
- Copy of Paindane Resort booking form and confirmation voucher
- Original vehicle registration papers & SA vehicle clearance form from SA border
- Duplicate vehicle keys
- 2 Red triangles per vehicle if towing and a fitted red triangle to front of

towing vehicle

- A yellow safety waistcoat
- Vehicle third party - purchased on the Mozambique side of the border (this you can also purchase at the Sasol garage outside Komatipoort)
- Drinking water
- Tyre pump and pressure gauge, tool kit and basic spares (fan belt etc), tow rope or strap
- Good flash light and batteries
- Camera
- Hat, sun glasses, sun screen, Malaria prophylaxis and insect repellent.
- Small first aid kit and personal medications

When driving in Mozambique wear seat belts and observe the speed limit in all towns. The minimum speeding fines can be high and spot fines are imposed.

Situated 485km north of Maputo, access by road is on a tarred road which is suitable for normal vehicles. The road from Maputo has been upgraded and resurfaced and offers a much more pleasant driving experience.

Please note that there are numerous towns and villages en-route and the main road often passes directly through these villages. Speed limits are enforced in these places and it is advised to drive with caution. Do not drive at night. The drive from Maputo to Inhambane can take anything between 6 – 8 hours and sufficient time needs to be allowed to avoid night driving.

How to get to Painsane from Johannesburg

Take the N4 - past Witbank, Nelspruit and all the way to the Komatipoort border.

Once through the Ressa Garcia border post, follow the main toll road to Maputo

As you enter Maputo proceed through the toll gate and shortly after take a left turn onto EN1 to Xai-Xai. This is the main coastal road north.
